The Eucharist has always been one of the most important aspects of Christianity. asserts the "Real Presence" of Jesus' body in the Eucharist; the sacrament is not symbolic of the body and blood of Jesus but rather that it is his body and blood. it represents the last meal that Christ had before being taken to the cross; it symbolizes Christ's connection with people and allows people to see that everyone is invited to dine with Christ once they have been accepted into Heaven. The Eucharist is a source of grace from Christ to all of the people who want to dine with Him the bread and wine become the figurative body of Christ.is used to represent the disciples who dined with Christ at His last meal

True Faith in the Lord Jesus Christ: as the person who approaches the Holy Communion must be a Christian Orthodox believer, baptized in the Orthodox Church, and strongly believes in the transubstantiation of the Bread to the Body of Christ, and the mixture into the Precious Blood of Christ,

and that Recalling these words of Jesus, the Catholic Church professes that, in the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest.¹the Communion is the actual Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus.²

Eucharist, also called Holy Communion or Lord's Supper, in Christianity, ritual commemoration of Jesus' Last Supper with his disciples, at which (according to tradition) he gave them bread with the words, "This is my body," and wine with the words, "This is my blood."³
