

# DECLARATION OF FAITH

## “a Child of God”

My beliefs, affirmations and commitments shall be my truth and good confession to lay hold onto a Faith-Based life as a Citizen in the Kingdom of God at His Throne of Grace.

### I AFFIRM THAT

- My belief that God is the father of all believers as "Genuine" under the righteousness of faith. (Romans 4:11)
- My heart is totally surrendered and open to the will and purpose of God. (Psalm 139:23-24; Proverbs 28:9; Ephesians 2:10)
- "Ownership of my Spirit is of God" the Father. (II Timothy 2:19)
- The Holy Spirit itself beareth witness with my spirit, that I am a Child of God. (Romans 8:16)
- Jesus Christ possesses all power in heaven and in earth. (Matthew 28:18)
- "My Spiritual Identity" is a seal that represents my inhabitation, standing and personal journey in the Kingdom at the Lord's Throne of Grace. (Ephesians 1:13, 14, Ephesians 2:19)
- "I am Sealed" by the Father. (John 6, 27; Ephesians 4:30)
- I am "Securely" sealed unto the time of my redemption. (Ephesians 1:13, 14)
- I am Blessed, Chosen, Adopted, Redeemed, Forgiven, Sealed, Loved and Saved by the Lord. (Ephesians 1:3-15)
- I became a Christian by the operation of God alone. God has never fellowshiped with un-regenerated men in any dispensation until man receives a new nature from Him. (John 3:6, 7, 1 Peter 2:4)
- Being a Christian is my legal evidence that "I am a Finished Transaction" under Christ. (II Corinthians 5:17-18)
- I am a follower of Christ ready to lay down my life in martyrdom every day in the little and big sacrifices required.
- I am not living an altered physical life from its original state or adopted an alternate lifestyle in opposition of God's "Law of Reproduction" (Leviticus 20:13, 1 Corinthians 6:9; Leviticus 18:22)
- When I make a vow to God, I will not delay fulfilling it. I accept and acknowledge that he has no pleasure in fools and I will be guilty of Sin. I am aware that if I refrain from making a vow, I will not be guilty. (Ecclesiastes 5:4; Deuteronomy 23:21-22)
- Life is a journey of learning and that no one ever arrives. I am not only willing to learn from God but also from others. (Psalm 119:33-35, Ephesians 4:11-12)

### I BELIEVE THAT

- There is one eternal God who is the Creator of all things. He exists in three persons: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. (Deuteronomy 6:4; Isaiah 45:5; Matthew 28:19; John 4:24; 2 Corinthians 13:14; Ephesians 4:6; 1 John 5:7)
- God is Spirit, Self-Existent, Truth, Love, Holy and Eternal (Genesis 1:1; Exodus 3:14; Numbers 23:19; Isaiah 6:3; Leviticus 11:44; Psalm 90:2; Psalm 145:17; Ecclesiastes 3:1; John 4:24; 1 John 4:7)
- God provides divine healing through prayer and laying on of hands. (Matthew 8:17; 1 Peter 2:24; James 5:14-15)
- Jesus Christ is the Son of God. He was crucified, died and was buried. He physically rose from the dead and ascended into heaven, where He remains at the right hand of God. (John 1:1; John 3:16; Acts 1:9-11; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Revelation 20:6)
- Fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge. (Psalms 33:8; Proverbs 1:7)
- The Bible is God's word. It is the final authority in all matters of doctrine and faith above all human authority and is the supreme standard by which all human conduct will be judged. (Proverbs 28:9; 11 Timothy 3:16)
- I was born a sinner that needed to be saved. Jesus Christ is my only savior. (Romans 3:23, 5:12; John 14:6; Acts 4:12)
- Salvation is through the blood of Jesus and calling on His name. (Luke 24:47; 1 Peter 1:18-19; Romans 10:9-10; 1 Corinthians 6:11)
- Water Baptism in the Holy Spirit is given to believers who ask for it as a testimony of their salvation. (Acts 1:4-8, 2:38-39, 8:35-38; 1 Corinthians 12:13)
- Water Baptism in the name of the Father the Son and the Holy Spirit, and Communion are to be observed by the church today. (Matthew 28:19; 1 Corinthians 11:24-30)
- I have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that I might know the things that are freely given to me of God. (Romans 8:9-11; 1 Corinthians 2:12)
- My righteousness comes from the Lord and (Isaiah 54:17) enables me to reign in life. (Romans 5:17)
- By grace I am saved through faith. (Romans 5:2; Ephesians 2:8)
- Marriage is the unification between a man and a woman whose nature and purposes are established by God. (Genesis 1:26-27; Genesis 2:23-24; Matthew 5:13-16; Isaiah 60:1-5; John 17:21; Ephesians 5:31-32; Leviticus 18:22)
- The church will be raptured and there will be a second coming of Jesus Christ. (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17; Titus 2:13)

### I COMMIT TO

- Fear God and keep his commandments. (Ecclesiastes 12:13; Proverbs 28:14)  
Matthew 22:36-40; Galatians 5:22-23
  - Love the Lord thy God with all my heart, and with all my soul, and with all my mind. (Ephesians 5:2)
  - Love my neighbor as myself. (Matthew 7:12)
- Exodus 20:1-17
  - Have no other gods before the Lord my God. (Leviticus 5:4-6; Deuteronomy 13:6-9; Proverbs 26:1,4,5,9-12; Matthew 5:33-37, 6:24; James 5:12)

  - NOT take the name of the Lord my God in vain.
  - Remember the Sabbath day, and keep it holy.
  - Honor my father and my mother.
  - NOT bear false witness against my neighbor.

  - NOT murder.
  - NOT commit adultery.
  - NOT steal.
  - NOT covet.
- Honor, glorify, and worship God. (Ephesians 5:20; Revelation 4:11)
- Glorify God in the conduct of my life, a lifestyle of praise and worship. (Proverbs 20:7; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20)
- Remain determined to know God and his word. (Proverbs 28:9; Matthew 5:6; 1 Peter 2:2)
- Seek the things of God as a priority over the things of the world. (Matthew 6:33; Psalms 1:6)
- Avoid slander, inappropriate speech, inappropriate relations and inappropriate works of any kind. (Proverbs 8:13; Ephesians 4:29; 5:3-7)
- Maintain and reaffirm the identity that God has given to me in Jesus Christ and His word. (Proverbs 22:1)
- Not be arrogant, misleading, murderous, mischievous, a false witness or person of conflict. (Proverbs 6:16-19)
- Attend physical local church services that are facilitated under a divine order. (1 Corinthians 11:3, 8-9; Ephesians 2:19)
